



Monthly Activities – July 2025

1. Financial assistance for educational purpose

1.1 Cheque number 846357 dated 24-7-2025 for Rs.10,000/- drawn in favour of Sri Kalyana Chakravarthy Memorial Educational Trust towards part tuition fees of Ms. M. Jhansi daughter of Ms. Satyavathi , studying 2nd year Intermediate in Sri Chaitanya Junior College, Visakhapatnam, was handed over to her by Ms. G. Bharathi, Member, Visakhapatnam on 27-7-25.

Ms.Satyavathi is a Cook with an annual income of about Rs. 70,000/-.
