1. Financial assistance for educational purpose

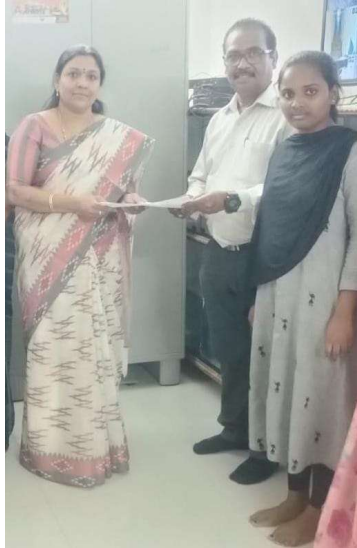
1.1 Cheque number 846347 dated 7-6-2025 for Rs.10,000/- drawn in favour of Principal, Vignan Junior College towards part tuition fees of Mr. G. Kameswaramma, Member, Hyderabad on 14-6-25.

Ms. Sravana Sandhya is a Cook with an annual income of about Rs.1,44,000/-.

5.1 Visits to Vaishnavi Old Age and Retirement Home ("Vaishnavi" for short)
